

## DISCORSO DI SUA SANTITÀ PIO PP. XII AD UN GRUPPO DI PARTECIPANTI AL IV CONGRESSO DELL'«INTERNATIONAL COLLEGE OF SURGEONS»\*

Venerdì, 12 giugno 1953
